★ Color the pictures of some of the incredible birds God made!







### Day 5 DINO Day

#### LET'S CLEAR UP THE CONFUSION

The Bible gives us the truth about dinosaurs. God made dinosaurs on day six about 6,000 years ago. And they were "very good." (Genesis 1)

Draw a picture of Adam with a dinosaur.

Draw a picture of fruits and veggies a *T. rex* may have munched on in the beginning.

All animals and people ate only plants in the beginning. (Genesis 1)

Draw a picture of dinosaurs entering Noah's ark.

After the flood went away and Noah's family and the animals came off the ark, they began to move to different parts of the world. Job was a man who wrote about a dinosaur (called "behemoth") he saw (Job 40). Some people drew pictures of the dinosaurs they saw.

After Adam sinned, the animals changed and began to eat each other. Soon, God judged the sin of mankind with a worldwide flood. God saved Noah's family and the animals on the ark. (Genesis 3–9)

Trace the picture of the animal that Native Americans drew on a rock. It looks like a dinosaur!



Eventually, like many other animals, dinosaurs died out (became extinct). Maybe they didn't have access to as much food. Maybe people hunted them too much. But there's no mystery when we use our BIBLE glasses to study dinosaurs!
