- Deuteronomy 8:2
- True obedience is revealed when a person has the opportunity to disobey.
- · "Jesus was led by the Spirit"
- "To be tempted by the devil" Ephesians 6:11
- No one is exempt from temptation. I Corinthians 10:13
- How do believers prepare for temptation?
  - 1. Spend time alone with God. James 4:8 | I Chronicles 16:11
  - 2. Be sure to be "Led by the Spirit." Psalm 143:10 | Acts 8:29
  - 3. Know and rely on Scripture, not feelings. James 1:12 | Proverbs 4:5

## Matthew 4:2
