  - "Ashamed"
  - People who are openly ashamed of Jesus Christ.
  - Shame that is exhibited in school curriculum.
  - Shame that is exhibited in the media. **II Timothy 3:1, 4, 5**
  - Believers must guard themselves against the battering ram of worldly pressure.
  - Believers must not remain silent. **I Peter 3:15**

  - The Word of God is under attack. **Genesis 3:1**
  - "Did God really say" **Mark 13:31**
