

I Corinthians 11:23

- “Bread” – Formally connected to the Exodus now came to represent the body of Christ.

I Corinthians 11:24

- “This is my body”
- “Which is for you.”

I Corinthians 11:25

- “The cup.” Represented the blood of the lamb smeared on the doorposts and lintels prior to the exodus.
- The cup now represents the blood of the Lamb of God shed for the sins of the world.
- The Old Covenant. Repetition.
- The New Covenant. Once and for all.
- The Old Covenant. Egypt to Canaan.
- The New Covenant. Earth to Heaven.

I Corinthians 11:26

- “You proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.”

I Corinthians 11:27

- “In an unworthy manner.”

- “Guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.”
